Financial aid to students from poor families

Sriwijaya University (UNSRI) has addressed the problem of poverty through our employers and economic centers in our community by providing students from poor backgrounds with quality education, for various fields of study. Our university also has bursary scholarships from several private and public companies.



UNSRI provides financial assistance to students from poor families to meet their basic needs through the 'Bidikmisi' Program. This program is dedicated exclusively to poor families. Basic student needs include food, water, accommodation, clothing, sanitation, education, health, and the internet. Since 2020, this program has changed its name to the Smart Indonesia Card Program (KIP).

Four 5-storey dormitories are available for students of the Bidikmisi Program at the Inderalaya campus of UNSRI. Each floor consists of 25 rooms and each room can accommodate 4 students. Internet access is available free of charge at the dormitory.
