"Net zero emissions" refers to a state in which the amount of greenhouse gases released into the atmosphere is balanced by an equivalent amount removed or offset, resulting in no net increase in the concentration of these gases. Greenhouse gases, such as carbon dioxide (CO₂) and methane (CH₄), are responsible for trapping heat in the Earth's atmosphere, leading to global warming and climate change.
